### GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Pumpkins (55323)
- GO! Square-6½" (55000)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Value Die (55018)

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—½ yard
- Fabric 2—¼ yard
- Fabric 3—1 yard (includes binding)
- Fabric 4—¾ yard
- Fabric 5—⅛ yard or fat quarter
- Fusible web product—½ yard
- Backing—25" x 48"
- Batting—25" x 48"

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics for appliqué following manufacturer's instructions.*

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 3—6½" squares
- Cut 8—2½" squares
- Cut 42—2" finished half square triangles

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 42—2" finished half square triangles

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 4—2½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF)  
*Sub cut into 10—2½" x 10½" sashing rectangles*
- Cut 4—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 2—tall pumpkins
- Cut 1—short pumpkin

#### Fabric 4:

- Cut 3—2½" strips across the WOF for border  
*Sub cut into 2—2½" x 18½" rectangles; and 2—2½" x 38½" rectangles*
- Cut 1—wide pumpkin

#### Fabric 5:

- Cut 6—2½" squares
- Cut 1—tall pumpkin
- Cut 1—wide pumpkin
- Cut 1—short pumpkin

## SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
2. Lay out shapes using photo as a guide on 6½" background fabric squares.
3. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions.
4. Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine.
5. Pin and sew one Fabric #1 and one Fabric #2, 2" finished half square triangles right sides together. Press seam toward darker fabric. Make 42 half square triangle units.
6. Lay out one appliquéd block center with 14 half square triangle units and two Fabric #5, 2½" squares.
7. Pin and sew together to complete block. Press seams in direction for least bulk. Make three blocks.
8. Pin and sew one Fabric #3, 2½" x 10½" sashing rectangle between blocks and on top and bottom of row of blocks. Press seams toward sashing rectangles.
9. Pin and sew four Fabric #1, 2½" squares and three Fabric #3, 2½" x 10½" sashing rectangles together. Press seams toward sashing rectangles. Make two sets.
10. Pin and sew to long sides of quilt center. Press seams toward sashing units.
11. Add 2½" Fabric #4 strips for border. Press seams toward sashing units.

## QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
